Use a clear font of at least 72 point for the title

Body copy should be at least 36 point

Avoid italics, decorative typefaces and underlining

Opt for clear fonts like this one.

Use direct, simple language

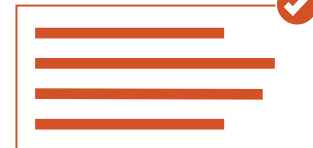
Help

Follow a linear, uncluttered, logical design



Align text to the left



Add alt text to images



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Use quality, relevant images to convey the message

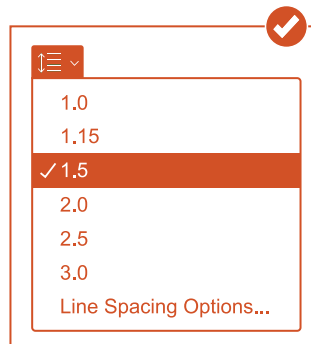


Use a dark font against a light background

This works really well

Design with mobile touchscreen in mind

Ensure line spacing is at least 1.5 times the font size



Lines of text that are too cramped can be difficult to read
